How do you subscribe for units in Tendo AB's rights issue?

Are you not an existing shareholder?

If you are not a shareholder in the company, you do not receive unit rights, then you either need to buy unit rights on the market and then use them for subscription or subscribe for units without the support of rights. There are two options for subscribing for units without rights, either you contact your bank and subscribe for units directly through them or you subscribe directly on Nordic Issuing's platform: <u>https://minasidor.nordic-issuing.se/</u>. The subscription period runs during the period 2024-04-08 to 2024-04-22, please note that some banks may close their subscription period earlier.

Do you already own shares and thus have received unit rights?

Are your shares held in a bank?

Subscription and payment must be made in accordance with instructions from your respective bank. Please note that when subscription with preferential rights takes place via a bank or trustee, this should be done early in the subscription period because each bank can set different time limits on the last day for subscription.

Are your shares held directly in a VP-account?

Subscription can then be carried out by means of simultaneous payment according to the pre-printed payment notice attached to the issue statement. If you wish to subscribe for a different number of units than what is stated on the pre-printed issue statement, you must complete the subscription on Nordic Issuing's platform <u>https://minasidor.nordic-issuing.se/.</u>

Please note that subscription to an investment savings account (ISK) or capital insurance account (KF) must be done via the bank or trustee that maintains the account.
